Have you ever heard of a clover mite? We didn't think so. A clover mite is a small reddish to dark brown pest often seen on sunny days in the early summer months. They have been known to invade a structure in large quantities. Clover mites belong to the arachnid group of arthropods because they have eight legs. The size of a clover mite is 1/30 of an inch.

Clover mites are considered a pest not for their bite but for the red stain that they leave when they are squished. They do not cause any damage to a structure or bite.

The diet of a clover mite consists of well fertilized grass and lawns or on rooftops where there is a mold or mildew growth.

Clover mites are also sometimes called spider mites.
